

## Global Medical Assistance

AmeriCares Global Medical Assistance Program provides medicines and medical supplies on an ongoing basis to 3,000 hospitals, clinics and community health programs worldwide. By providing lifesaving products that are unavailable or financially inaccessible, we help health care providers in the poorest regions of the world deliver high-quality health care.



## Emergency Response

Our emergency response teams are often the first on the ground after natural and man-made disasters delivering lifesaving medical assistance and other urgently needed relief supplies. When it becomes clear that a longer-term response is needed, AmeriCares launches post-emergency program initiatives to help impacted communities rebuild.

## Medical Outreach Program

AmeriCares Medical Outreach Program donates medical products to U.S.-based health care professionals traveling overseas as volunteers to provide primary care services and surgeries for people in desperate need. Each year, we supply medicines for 1,000 medical trips. The program also donates products to orthopedic surgeons in the United States performing charitable surgeries.



## AmeriCares in the U.S.

Here at home, AmeriCares supports 400 clinics serving the uninsured and underinsured with prescription and over-the-counter medicines, as well as medical supplies. We deliver more than \$20 million worth of medical aid to U.S. clinics each year. In addition, our Patient Assistance Program provides free prescription medications for more than 100,000 people living with chronic diseases. In our home state of Connecticut, we operate three AmeriCares Free Clinics that provide primary and specialty care for our low-income neighbors without health insurance.





### Our Model


